This standard establishes minimum legionellosis risk management requirements for building water systems including their design.

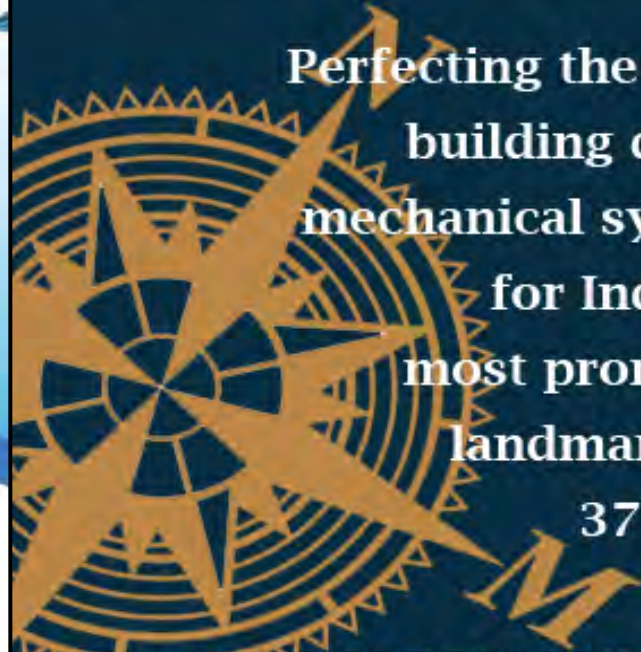

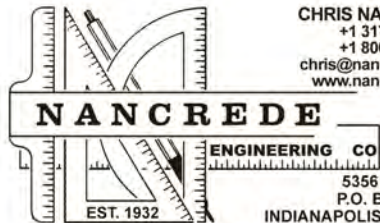
