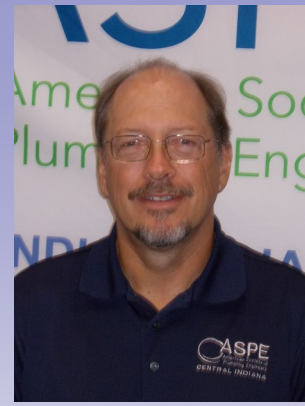

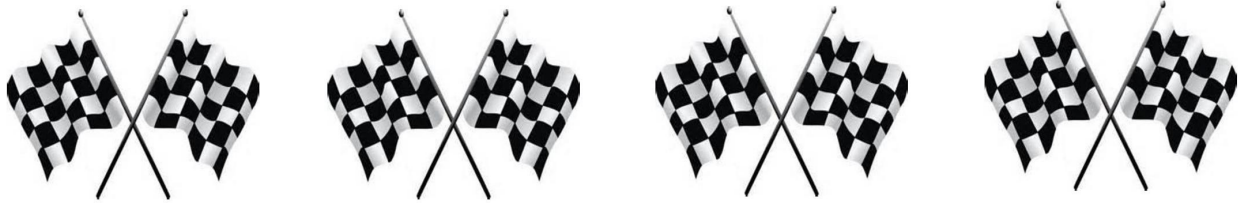
For our April meeting we will have Bret Abner from Auto Brine in to speak on bulk brine systems.

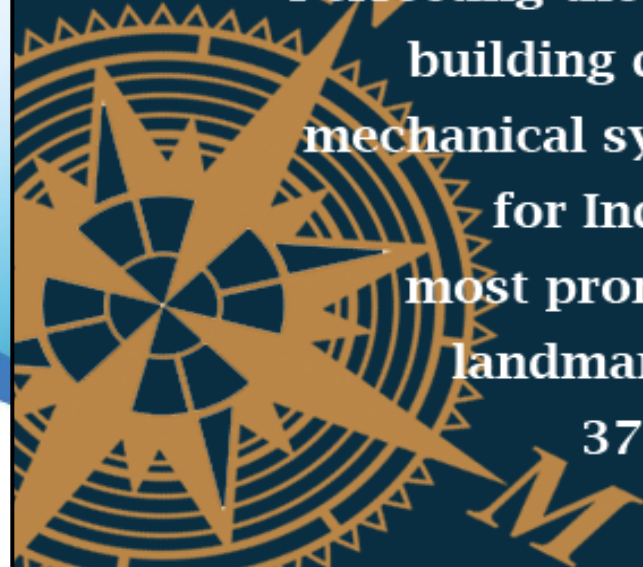
