From the President:

I can't believe October is here already! The summer flew by and the weather was a little unseasonable and extreme, either wet, or hot, or cool. Typically I wouldn't be too bothered, but I was reroofing my house all through September and the weather played a big part in that project. I do love the fall though, so with the roof project done, hopefully I can enjoy the season! I'm looking forward to a fall foliage motorcycle ride through Brown County, and a camping trip this weekend!

So, for our September meeting we had Shawn Donahue with Armacell/Knauf Insulation and I must confess, I learned a lot of new things about insulation! Shawn did a great job and his presentation was done very well! It was good to get a brush-up on the basics, but he quickly went into energy savings, equipment and system performance which all goes back to energy savings, or loss. If everything is performing at the optimum range, less energy is used, equipment will last longer, and ultimately the owner saves money. That's a very big deal. So, something as simple as a good insulation installation can mean the difference between a cost efficient economical system with longevity and a money sucking short life-span system. Tough choice! Also, at our September meeting we had a representative from Vectren there to inform us of the rebate programs they have available to their customers for kitchen and mechanical equipment, such as \$50 per Low Flow Pre-Rinse Sprayer, or a \$500/unit rebate for a new $\geq 90\%$ Boiler (<300 MBH) up to \$5,000/unit for a $\geq 90\%$ Boiler ($\geq 1,000$ MBH), or how about \$150/unit rebate on tankless water heaters, and \$3/LF on insulated hot water piping! There are many many more offers available. You can get more details by contacting Abby Vaal at 812-431-7579.

We also held a meeting for our Fort Wayne colleagues on September 14th which was well attended. Mr. Dave Parney with the Cast Iron Soil Pipe Institute (CISPI) was there to give a technical program on the benefits of cast iron piping systems. I've attended one of their programs in the past and I know it was highly educational. Every piping system material has a time and place for their use, but when it comes to cast iron drainage piping, it gives me a "warm and fuzzy feeling" as Gary Mohr would say. It gives me confidence that my design will hold up and it's quiet too. We will be holding more meetings throughout the year in Fort Wayne on every other month for now until we can determine if there's enough interest to hold them every month and eventually start a satellite chapter.

For our October meeting in Indy we'll have Ken Rutherford with Amtrol presenting on "Commercial Expansion Tank Applications" so mark your calendar. There is more detailed information elsewhere in this issue.

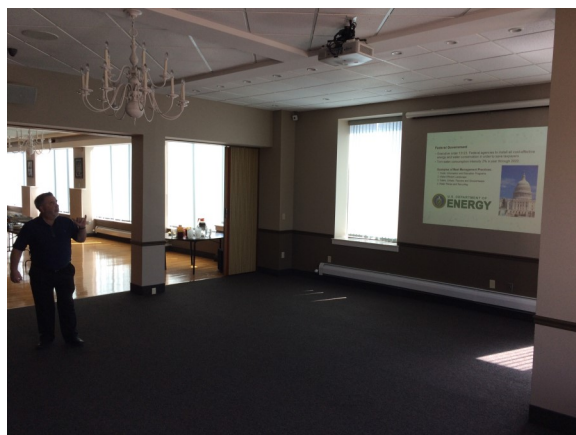

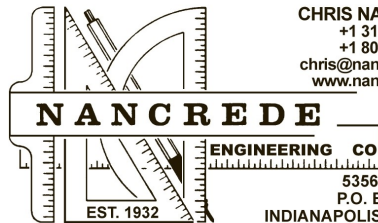
