Location: **Ironwood Golf Club** – 10955 Fall Road, Fishers, IN 46038. (317) 842-0551. Ironwood Golf Club is located (3) miles east of I-69 between 106th and 116th Streets. From 106th Street – turn left (north) on Fall Road. From 116th Street – turn right (south) on Hoosier Road. Follow the golf course signs to guide you to the course.

Entry Fee: **\$85.00 per Player** – Includes green fees, cart, range balls (used for driving range prior to the start of the event), awards, prizes, beverages, lunch and dinner.

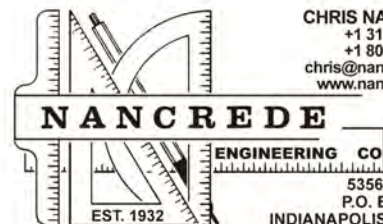

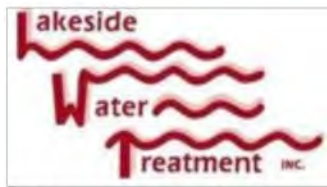

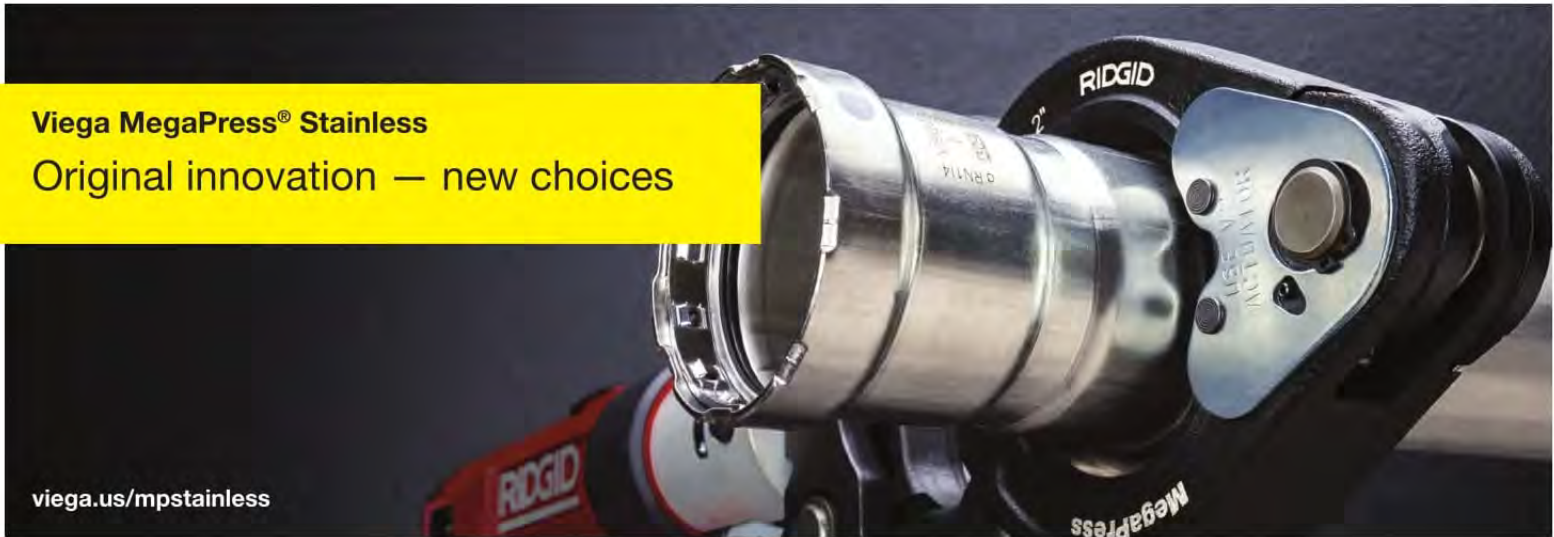
