

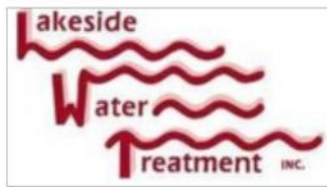

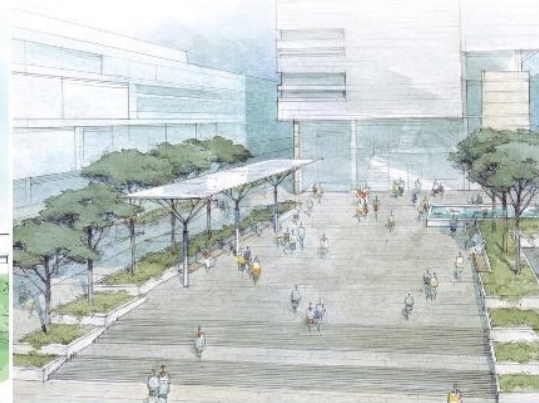

Speaker Bio:

Brennan Doherty

My name is Brennan Doherty and I am a regional manager for MIFAB: a Chicago based plumbing manufacture specializing in Drainage, Plastic Grease interceptors, S/S Trench, Couplings, Access Doors, Trap Primers, and countless other products such as Siphonic Roof Drains which I will be presenting at the ASPE Lunch on Sept 20th. I reside in the Chicago-land area where I have my whole life, and am currently the acting Corresponding Secretary for the Chicago Chapter of ASPE. I cover the central part of the United States, and am looking forward to Atlanta at the end of the month.

With the changes to IPC 2015 code, engineers are now having to size their gravity roof drains using GPMs which is causing them to be larger diameters. Siphonic systems are nearly twice as efficient at half the size allowing for there to be fewer penetrations on the roof, greater flow rates through the drains, and an overall lower cost on the job. I look forward to discussing the advantages, and answering any questions about the application.

Rick consults with a number of firms in the Midwest in the area of High Purity Water Treatment, designing systems in Central Sterile Processing, Hemodialysis, Laboratories, Pharmaceuticals, as well as Industrial systems, and legionella and other bacterial remediation. Rick is a paid consultant for the CMS (Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services) and is an active member of the AAMI (Association for the Advancement of Medical Instrumentation).

Andy Baker is a 1995 graduate of Xavier University in Cincinnati, Ohio. He started his career in water in 2003 at a 510k FDA (Food and Drug Administration) medical manufacturing facility. By 2005, Andy was production manager and part owner of the company. After selling the business to SUEZ in 2010, Andy continued to work there until 2016 when he and his father Jim Baker started a new venture, Nu Stream Filtration.
