## HITS Conference Wrap-up

For the last 8 to 10 months I have written to you about the HITS Conference coming to Buffalo, NY and how you should attend. Outside of the Technical Symposium, ASPE Region 2 could not have asked for a better healthcare related forum right in our own backyards. The conference is behind us but the stories, experiences, research, and statistics shared by the presenters and by those in the audience will, like it or not, affect the designs of every healthcare facility you will be a part of in the future.

The passion of actress Alicia Cole (Beverly Hills 90210, American Tragedy, Veronica Mars) when she spoke from the audience about her near-fatal case of a flesh-eating disease kept everyone in focus.

If any of you follow Christoph Lohr, PE, CPD on Twitter (full discloser...I don't tweet) you would have seen statistics presented to the audience like the "odds of you being involved in a plane crash is 1 in 11 million; but the odds of getting a hospital infection is 1 in 25". You'll also see his collage of selfies with industry notables; <https://twitter.com/LohrThoughts>

As the keynote speaker, Dr. Sanjay Saint, Chief of Medicine at the VA Ann Arbor Healthcare System emphasized that **"culture is defined as the worst behavior a leader is willing to tolerate"** and that **"example is the best way for leaders to influence behavior."** Take a look around your office. Is the goal to get the engineering done quickly and out the door to invoice, or is it to do whatever it takes to get it right?

Here is a stat you probably do not want to know. How many microbes are spread in a sink bowl during hand washing? With an automatic faucet, 20,800,000; with a manual faucet, 71,600,000. I'm guessing there is room for improvement here when it comes to product design (faucet, bowl, and drainage), water flow patterns, and a better understanding of how ineffective we wash our own hands. Yikes!

Kristen VanderElzen, MPH, CIC presented on the construction of healthcare facilities and patient room designs. Many of the people in the room were taken back by the information she presented. Even the infection preventionists. During open discussions later each day, people continued to refer to what she brought forward. ASPE may wish to seek her out to present at one of their educational forums. I know our Eastern MI Chapter is trying to finalize a plumbing engineering educational program for April 14, 2020 to be held at NSF. Pencil this date into your calendar. Christoph Lohr is presenting, Kristen may be a part of our program too.

The final day of the conference focused on water. Janet Stout, Ph.D. lead the charge with **"Ending Legionnaires' Disease: An Audacious or Achievable Goal?"** Although a somber topic, Janet in her own unique way, adds humor to help get her *Legionella* message out. It is anticipated she will give this same presentation during the Technical Symposium.

Sarah Clock, Ph.D., MPH from NewYork-Presbyterian Hospital (NYPH) spoke on **"Looking Beyond Legionella: What do We Know about Transmission Risks from Hospital Water?"** Ideally it is to prevent biofilm formation. Consider during the construction and commissioning phases to not tie in domestic water systems until necessary; fill the system with water for pressure testing, then drain down if occupancy is not immediate or is delayed. A side note, pressurizing with air can be very dangerous and fatal to a skilled trades person working on the system. All fixtures that are plumbed in must be flushed; treat (i.e. chlorine) just before occupancy, and institute a regular flushing program right away.

Sarah is an active member of the NYPH water management team. Their team was recently presented with the 2018 ASHE Excellence in HealthCare Facility Management Award.

Molly Scanlon, Ph.D., FAIA, FACHA gave a wonderful presentation titled **"Water Safety During Construction Activities: Avoiding the 'Perfect Storm' a systematic review"** on a research project she has been working on. It deals with the number of hazardous conditions of construction relating to water. The data was staggering for both healthcare and the surrounding community. It was the first time this was shared in a public setting. I'm not going to spoil her research by giving out some of the information. She is hopeful the research paper will be published sometime this Fall. This will be a game changer. Plan to read it cover-to-cover. It will be followed by more research.

ICC Class: "2014 InBC Firestopping - Plan Review and Inspection"

This training is designed for Plans Examiners, Fire and Building Inspectors, Contractors, Architects and Engineers. We will review the firestopping requirements of the 2014 Indiana Building Code, as well as hold a general discussion as to why firestop inspections have proven to be one most difficult challenges for code officials. Methods to achieve code-compliant firestop systems for joints, perimeter containment, through and membrane-penetrations will be provided, and we will discuss the new ASTM firestop inspection standards. This training will also provide an overview of draftstopping and fireblocking. Overall, attendees will leave this program encouraged, informed and with helpful hints and techniques pertaining to their field of work.

This course consists of 6 contact hours and earns 0.6 ICC CEUs.

Presenter: Brice Miller

Mr. Miller has over 25 years experience as a Building Official, Inspector and Plans Examiner, and holds four International Code Council (ICC) certifications. He has provided firestop presentations to most state ICC Chapters throughout the country, and he proposed the ICC firestop inspector certification. Mr. Miller has assisted ICC with not only their firestop publications, but he has also had the opportunity to develop two full-day firestop presentations on their on-line firestop training. Mr. Miller is Past President of the Colorado Chapter of ICC, and served 2 2/1 years as the Executive Director of the International Firestop Council.
