2020 InRC: Chapter 11 Residential Energy Code

This course consists of six contact hours and earns .6 ICC PPN CEU's.

Course Description:

- This seminar will focus on the following three areas: Envelope, Mechanical & Documentation.
- At the end of each section there will be an interactive activity over some of the main focus points of the correlating section (testing requirements, documentation requirements, inspections, etc.)
- The lecture will begin with a summarized overview of energy code changes and compliance paths before going into specific details.
- Discuss additions/alteration requirements and exceptions.
- Explain building envelope and go into detail on corresponding prescriptive and mandatory requirements along with comparisons to the performance pathways.
- Discuss the new Indiana amended air leakage requirements and testing (will include a video with testing procedures).
- Discuss mechanical systems and equipment (BIG changes here).
- Discuss the new duct and duct testing requirements.
- Talk about new equipment sizing requirements (will include a hands-on portion going over what to look for when reviewing required reports).
- Discuss new mechanical ventilation and different options for whole house ventilation.
- Go over the rest of the mechanical requirements (pipe insulation, lighting, etc.).
- Go into detail on the permitting process and documentation requirements for all four compliance paths.

Speaker: Nate Kleist

Nate Kleist is a Purdue alumnus (Boiler Up!), HERS rater, IHADA weatherization auditor, is ICC certified and specializes in energy codes and design. He has spent the last eleven years fine tuning his expertise in the home energy rating industry at Energy Diagnostics, a Midwest rating firm based in Indiana, Michigan and Illinois. Nate works with and trains builders, code officials, design professionals and contractors on energy codes and industry best practices. He specializes in current IECC, and is involved in future development of energy codes. Nate has worked under several different variations of the 2009, 2012, 2015 and 2018 IECC, giving him a unique and robust look at the state adoption process, along with the benefits and concerns of each code and corresponding amendments.
