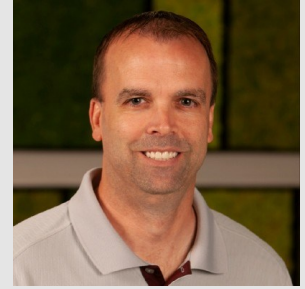

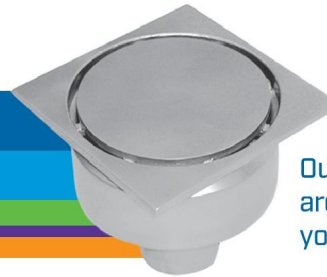

Entry Fee: **\$100.00 per Player** – Includes green fees, cart, range balls (used for driving range prior to the start of the event), awards, prizes, beverages, lunch, and dinner.

Deadline: Deadline for entry is **Friday, July 21nd, 2023**. All registration Forms and Payments ***must*** be received by this date please. **Late payments will be assessed a \$30 late fee if paid after that date. Electronic payments by July 21st are preferred!**

Meeting adjourned at 12:45 PM, next board meeting July 6th 2023, BDA Office 11:30am



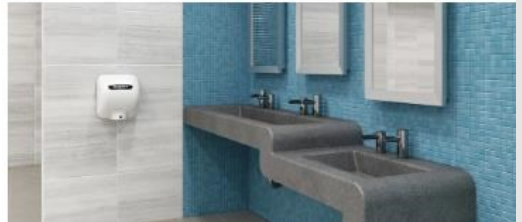
