VP Legislative News

The Fire and Building Services Commission will review comments on the proposed new Mechanical Code based on the 2021 ICC Mechanical Code, at their April 4th meeting. You can see all the actions they have taken on the codes so far here. The Commission will be reviewing the Fuel Gas Code at their next meeting. Each code being reviewed will only accept comments made through the section on their website by the date given. The Mechanical Code comments are due by March 7th.

HB 1575 has passed Committee and moved to the Senate. This will create an additional Residential Building Commission that will have the authority to overrule any code update recommendations the Fire and Building Safety Commission recommend beginning July of 2023. This commission will have the ability to amend the codes governing all One and Two Family Dwellings, Townhouses, swimming pools, and R2 and R3 occupancies.

What this has the potential to do is create 2 separate amendments for the same code books. The Fire and Building Safety Commission may choose or not choose to amend the International Model Codes: Fire Code, Existing Building Code, Building Code, Plumbing Code, Mechanical Code, Fuel Gas Codes for Class 1 structures and the Residential Commission can then amend those specifically for Class 2 structures.

This new Commission will have no representation from plumbers, hvac installers, or electricians to represent the Commission members yet they will be voting on amendments to those requirements.

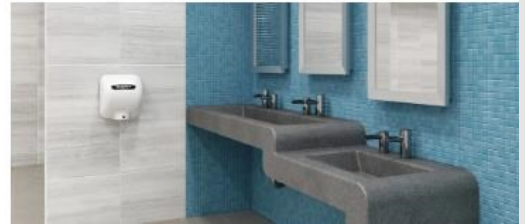

2023 Engineers Week News and Photos

Engineer's week took place February 19-25, 2023 this year. This year our chapter was proud to be able to present Plumbing Engineering to two construction classes at Clinton Prairie High School in Frankfort, Indiana. David Townsend and Frank Bruggner took the task of attending and teaching this two day event. We were able to provide a two day session to about 30 high school students from Freshman to Senior class ranks. The students in these construction classes have learned general carpentry, electrical, drywall and other construction areas. Our presentation of plumbing fit right in with their class schedule and learning objectives.



On the first day session we taught the two separate classes an overview of plumbing design and engineering. This class included going over different piping systems, pipe types and fitting methods. We also went into an introduction of sizing plumbing systems as well as going over a recent renovation project at their own high school. We concluded the

presentation with an overview of careers in the plumbing industry including career paths through college degrees and through trade school programs. In the sizing exercise, we provided the students with fixture unit charts, gpm charts and pipe size charts. The students were able to add up fixture units and convert it to gpm and ultimately obtain the pipe size from the final chart.

The second day we offered the student a hands-on experience at joining piping and fittings. The students were able to press copper fittings onto copper piping as well as joining PVC DWV fittings. For this session, we met in the school's wood shop where we had work tables to provide the students the necessary space to complete these two systems. We provided copper press elbows and copper piping as well as provided PVC piping, fittings, primer and glue. As a token of our appreciation of allowing us to present to the students, we provided each student in the class, bag with many plumbing manufacturer logoed items inside to further promote the plumbing industry.

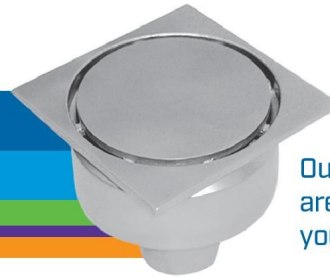

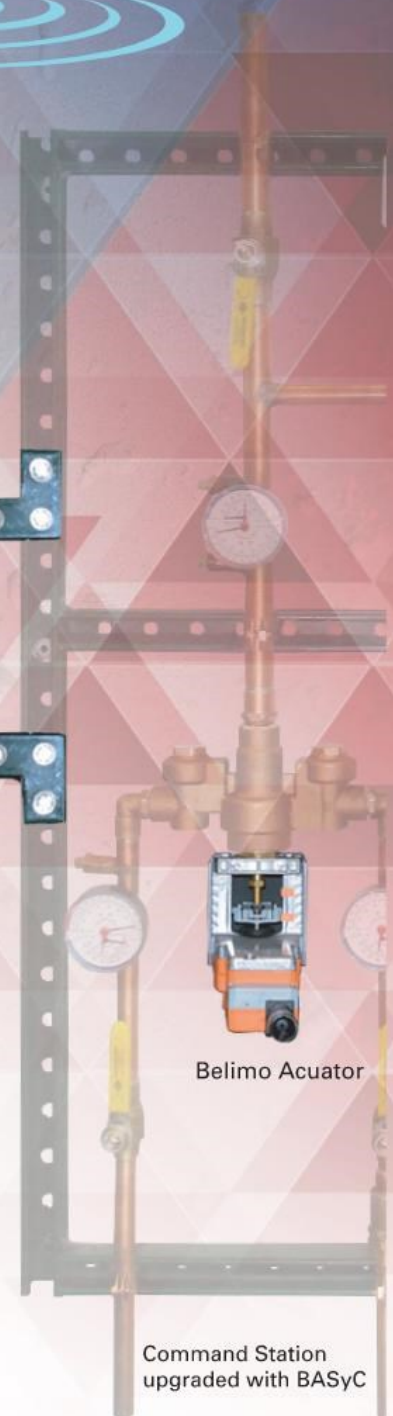


BASyC Control Panel
