Deadline: Deadline for Early Bird entry is Friday, July 11th, 2025.

All registration Forms and Payments must be received by this date please. Late payments will be assessed a \$30 fee if paid after that date. Electronic payments by July 11th are preferred!

Format Play: Four (4) Person Scramble played from the Blue Tees. After each team player shot, all players will play from the best shot of the four until a ball ends up in the cup. This allows players of varying skills to participate and contribute.
