Professionals who have the CPD credential are considered to have the highest level of skills in the design and specification of plumbing systems.

EARNING & MAINTAINING THE CPD CREDENTIAL

Am I eligible?

Route 1:

4 year engineering degree + 4 years of work experience designing plumbing systems

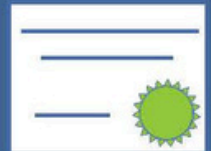
Route 2:

8 years of work experience designing plumbing systems

Current CPDT certification counts toward 1 year of experience



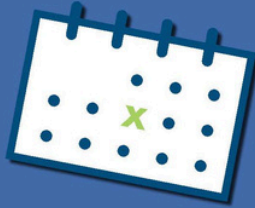
PE license counts toward 2 years of experience



When can I take the exam?



The exam is held **annually** in the spring



Registration typically opens in December prior to the exam date

Where do I take the exam?

Scores are **mailed** 6 to 8 weeks after the exam
